Small Groups are emerging all over the State to help you connect with those closest to you.

- Regional meetings, workshops and seminars provide educational opportunities on specific topics and go in more depth than conference sessions.
- Meet with a group that is familiar with the area you are in while providing more diverse knowledge than your small-group.
- Regionals typically provide credit for PHRP certification (and often count toward SHRM and HRCI certifications).
